

# Controlling your Screen Size

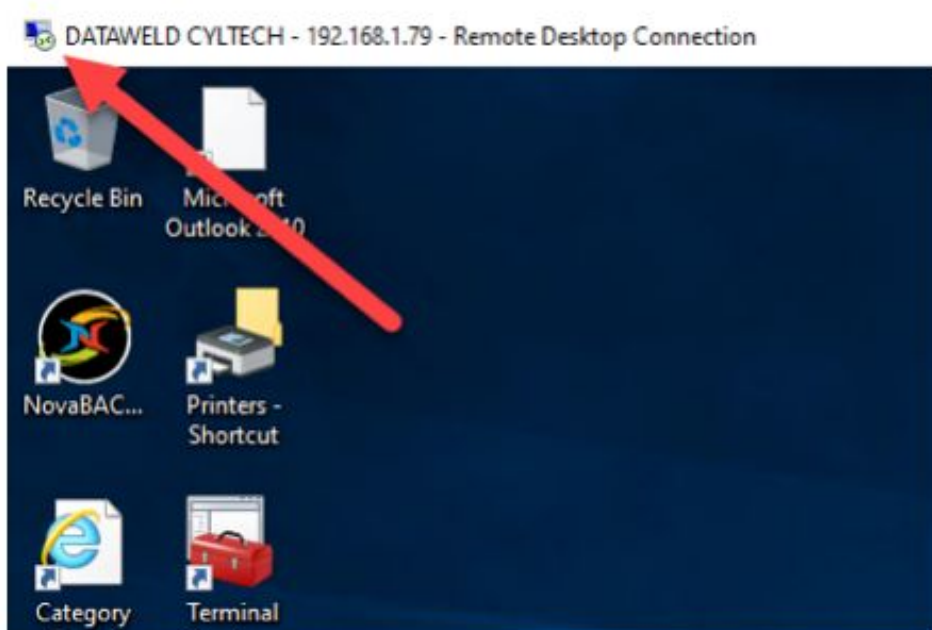


## Introduction:

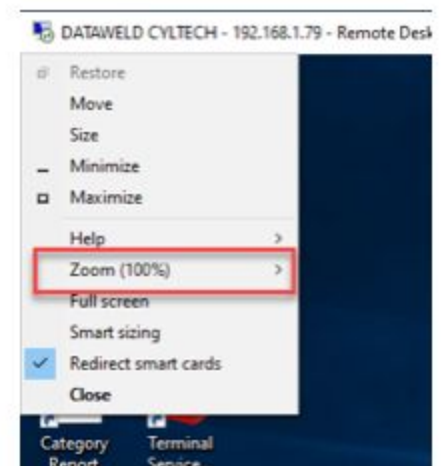
Everybody has a different opinion of how large or small a screen size should be. To accommodate all of these preferences, Microsoft offers a feature to adjust the screen size when connected to your server using an RDP session.

## Here's how you do it:

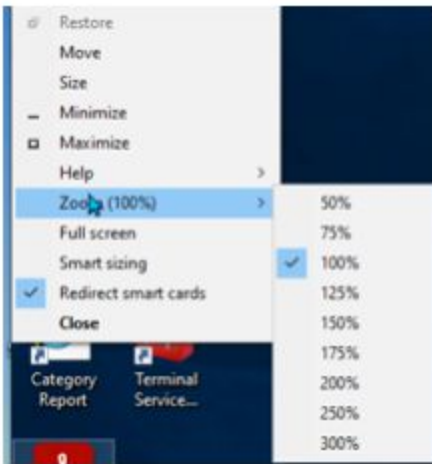
1. Once you are logged onto your server with an RDP session, press the CTRL, ALT and PAUSE/BREAK keys at the same time. At this point a second window should pop up.



2. At the top left of the screen is an image of a monitor, click on it.
3. After you click on the monitor you will see a drop-down menu.



4. At this point, move the cursor to Zoom and a secondary menu will appear showing the Zoom options.



5. Select the Zoom percentage you prefer. **Note:** when you exit your session, the screen size will default to the standard.
